## 1. General:

Curling is a team sport and as such the team suffers when a member of a team does not show up to play his/her game at any given time. It is understood that there are times when other commitments may interfere in a player's ability to play. Spares are used in this instance in order to ensure teams have a full complement of players and everyone enjoys the sport on a level paying ground.

This policy sets out the guidelines for the use of spares. It should be noted that these are guidelines and should be applied with common sense and in the spirit of good sportsmanship, fair play and in the interest of promoting the overall positive experience of membership in the Club.

## 2. Policy:

- 1. It is the responsibility of the individual member to find a replacement (spare) if they cannot meet their commitment to play.
- 2. A spare may be any eligible curler selected in accordance the priority below:
  - 1. A member of any bye team in the draw for that date
  - 2. A person listed on the league spare list
  - 3. Any other eligible curler
- 3. Eligible Curlers
  - Any member of the league
  - Any Unlimited Member
  - Any Single Draw Member of another league that has not yet spared outside of their league during this draw
  - A non-member that has paid the Non-Member Spare fee. The fee for non-members as set out in the Fee Schedule.
